**Rod Flinchbaugh** - bust of Bethoven done in butternut from the Vic Hood seminar.

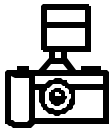
**Frank Lombardi**- several relief carvings and an elf holding a carving chisel.

The September program featured Gloria Heard who gave an excellent demonstration and lots of pointers on how to photograph carvings.

- Use a natural background, preferably gray.
- You want separation of the subject from the background
- Color photos printed in black and white come out good.
- All films today are daylight films.
- Blue bulbs are the best light but have a short lifespan.
- Always use a tripod
- Never photograph a subject straight on. It shows up flat with no dimension.
- Be aware of where the light is casting shadows so they do not detract from the subject.
