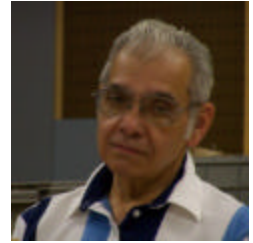
**West Shore Club Show**

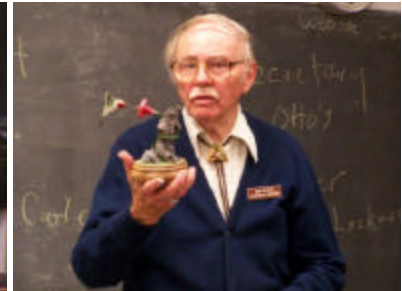

Bob Started carving in 1979 in York. He does not like carving with hand tools but loves power carving. With 37 years of art experience, he has found he likes to carve miniatures. Tupelo is a favorite carving wood of Bob, it does not tend to fuzz like bass wood. Bob Ziegler does not spend a lot of money on tools for his carvings. He uses a sewing machine motor to create his own power carver, uses gadgets and Jigs, and copper wire from old romex to make feet. Bob also makes his own eyes using the head of a straight pin and epoxy! Bob rarely uses a burner, he likes to stone his feathers. Bob brought us a few of his ribbon-winning birds, unfortunately he dropped some of them on the stairs and broke them.

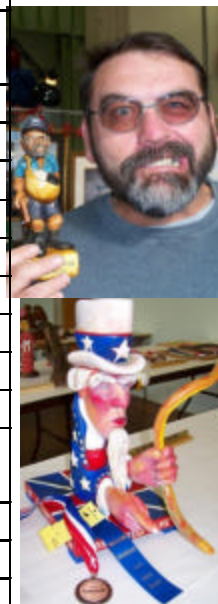
