

Jim Hiser and Ed Bolt have been looking into finding us new signs to advertise our show since the old ones are so heavy and hard to put out. They will finalize the details and report back to the show committee for final approval to buy the signs.

Nikki gave a packet of envelopes and show applications for Charlie Lockwood to send out as soon as Linda Murphy finalizes our show rules. Look for yours soon! Our Show Chair will do her best to get together a confirmation letter to send to those who reserve a table. If you know of a carver or retail supplier who may be interested in a table let Charlie know so he can get an application to them.


### **Door Prizes**
