

Oaxacan ('Wa- Hah- Kan') Carving

Oaxacan carving is a style of carving and painting popular in the Mexican state Oaxaca that became popular in the 1980's. Gary is a collector of this style of carving but has also tried a piece or 2 of his own.

The Oaxacan carvings are usually done in capalillo wood when it is still green. Most of the carvings are not a single piece of wood, they are often pieces fitted to-

gether and not even glued. This type of wood turns very hard when it is dry and is easily sanded to a smooth finish. The painting style sets these carvings apart from any others. They are very bright colors with lots of flowers or other bold designs. In fact, there are stories that "Magic Mushrooms" helped to inspire the painting on these carvings!
